**TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN**

This is to certify that the formula for Divos A1 does not contain more than 26% nitric acid.

In section 3.2 of the product SDS a range of 20 - 30% is communicated. It is complicated in our system to change these ranges. Considering that the purpose of section 3.2 is to enable the end user to '*.....identify readily the hazards of the substances in the mixture.*' (REACH Annex II, 3.2). The choice was made to add this statement regarding the composition of Divos A1, rather than manually adapting the SDS. REACH Annex II clearly describes that the objective of section 3.2 is not to be able to recalculate the mixture classification based on the provided information, since it is clearly stated in the legal text that '*The hazards of the mixture itself shall be given in section 2*'.

By maintaining the automated content of our SDS, we avoid problems with the SDS and its distribution in the future.
